“Just Fore Kids” Golf Classic raises \$1.3 million in 13 years

Louisville, Ky. (August 25, 2009) – In its 13th year, the annual Kosair Charities/Ronald McDonald Charities “Just Fore Kids” Golf Classic has raised a net \$1.3 million. The event consistently raises \$100,000 each year for area charities. The money raised is primarily split between two beneficiaries, Kosair Charities and the Ronald McDonald House. Additional contributions are made to other organizations that share the mission of helping children including First Tee, Urban Youth League and STAR.

“Our goal is always to net \$100,000 at each event,” said Bobby Clarkson, an organizer for the event. “The money raised each year helps us to give back to the community and help the children that need it most.”

More than 30 teams, 120 people, participate in the annual fundraiser at Hurstbourne Country Club.

According to Clarkson, the “Just Fore Kids” Golf Classic is one of the largest fundraising golf events in the region.
