They've seen the difference Kosair has made in families, and that's the only motivation they need to keep giving.

"I've known so many people over the years who have been helped by Kosair," said Harry. "Now they're successful people who may have never made it without the help Kosair Charities was able to offer. So many people don't have the luxury of health insurance, or the financial means necessary to meet the needs their family may have in a crisis situation, so I'm glad my family can help."
